**FUNERAL ARRANGEMENTS: MISS NOLUBABALO TOKO**

1. The 5 January 2021 correspondence regarding passing on of Miss Nolubabalo Toko refers.

2. Kindly be updated as follows:

2.1 The family is now ready to receive visitors from tomorrow Saturday, the 9<sup>th</sup> of January 2021 onwards.

2.2 Nolubabalo's interment will take place as follows:

Date: Tuesday the 12<sup>th</sup> of January 2021 at 08h00

Venue: Dikidikana Cemetery, Dikidikana Location, outside King William's Town

2.3 **The interment will be followed by a short service starting at 09h00 at the Toko Residence, Dikidikana Location.**

2.4 Directions to the Toko Residence at Dikidikana Location are as follows:

2.4.1 From King Williams Town take R63 on your right towards Alice.

2.4.2 Drive past Kwa-Masingatha turn off on your right (this being the first turn off with a "Bus Stop" sign on your right).

2.4.3 Drive past the second turn off on your right towards the Cricket Stadium. There is no Bus Stop sign here. You are now approaching the third turn off on your right (to Mdingi Clinic: no sign). This one has a Bus Stop sign on your right.

2.4.4 Take the right turn AND IMMEDIATELY turn left into the gravel road (This is approximately 6 kilometres from King William's Town Turn off).

2.4.5 Proceed with this gravel road driving parallel to R63 on your left.

2.4.6 Drive past the first junction on your right.

2.4.7 Turn into the second junction on your right and drive down till you hit what should have been a T- junction.

2.4.8 Drive towards your left until you go through two tall electrical poles.

2.4.9 Follow the road towards your right. On your right you will see a house with "Solar system" and that place is affectionately known as eNkandla by the Community members. Rev & Mrs Toko's house is next to eNkandla.

2.4.10 The maximum distance from King Williams Town to Reverend and Mrs Toko's residence is approximately 9 kilometres.

3. May we continue to hold the Toko family in prayers at this difficult time.
