Psalm 105

- 1 Give praise to the Lord, proclaim his name;
make known among the nations what he has done.
- 2 Sing to him, sing praise to him;
tell of all his wonderful acts.
- 3 Glory in his holy name;
let the hearts of those who seek the Lord rejoice.
- 4 Look to the Lord and his strength;
seek his face always.

- 5 Remember the wonders he has done,
his miracles, and the judgments he pronounced,

This is one of my favourite Psalms, it's a long one and I encourage you to read the rest of it. It gives a brief summary of the people of Israel. It's a reminder of what God has done for them. The Jews have a wonderful tradition of sharing their history and how God journeyed with them and the Psalmist calls them, and us, to make known what God has done.

While the Bible writings were compiled many centuries ago, God has not stopped being involved in our lives and we each have a story of what God has done in our own lives. Take some time today to think about your story and perhaps write out a brief summary of God's involvement. What wonderful acts do you have to tell about? What wonders have you seen God work? How does your life continue God's story?
