### Pray for the Ministers of the Gospel

*Ephesians 6: 19 – 20 And pray for me, too. Ask God to give me the right words so I can boldly explain God's mysterious plan that the Good News is for Jews and Gentiles alike. 20 I am in chains now, still preaching this message as God's ambassador. So pray that I will keep on speaking boldly for him, as I should.*

The call to pray for the preachers of the Gospel of Jesus's Christ, is imperative to those who are passionate about their faith and the salvation of mankind in totality. Those preachers who understand the essence of the Gospel will, in humility, forever bow their heads to receive prayers from those they minister to; this is a plea the Apostle Paul holds in high regard. The request to be prayed for, comes with a number of reasons which we pick as we read in Paul's Epistles/letters to different churches.

My dear friends, Preaching does not emerge from the preacher, neither from his wisdom, it is supposed to come from God Himself who knows the right spiritual food fit for His children at a particular space and time; otherwise food will be poisonous and fatal. It is therefore, the duty of the saints, to always pray for those who preach the word, so that God himself should provide the right words. It will be suicidal fellow pilgrims, to listen to a sermon that one didn't pray for. Some accusations on how bad the sermon of the day was, do not rest solely to the preacher but also to the saints who did not pay attention to the call to pray for the preacher. Devout Christians must never miss an opportunity to preach a sermon to themselves and others, through their tireless prayers. It should be considered by all to be criminal, to eat from the pot one didn't contribute to, through prayers towards the right wording of the preaching.

Furthermore, preachers have their own limitations, of which without the illuminations from above they cannot stretch beyond; they need prayers, your prayers, such that they are then enabled to dig deep into the deep secrets of the Almighty God, that only His Spirit can reveal (1 Corinthians 2: 6 – 16). That they are given the best of utterance, audibility, language that even the spiritual deaf can hear.
