A vacancy has arisen for the position of Minister of United Church of Christ the King (UCCCK) and expressions of interest are invited for consideration to fill the position. UCCCK is a United Congregation (Presbyterian/Episcopalian/Methodist/Congregationalist) situated in Maldean and Nunelport areas. Our membership reflects the residential demographics of the area, and current membership is 150/160 adults and 18 or so children.

The Minister will:

- Provide pastoral care to the congregation
- Preach and teach the Gospel of Jesus Christ
- Play with and for, intercede and counsel congregants and adherents in need
- Administer the Sacraments of the Christian church
- Attend and represent UCCCK at forums of the 4 denominations
- Be present at the Church a number of days per week to be jointly agreed, for counselling, Bible Study or other purposes and
- Generously build up the Congregation in its faith, service and witness to Jesus Christ.

The successful applicant will clearly (but not necessarily) also:

- Be fluent in the English language
- Possess a recognised tertiary qualification in a ministry or theological field, and
- Have verifiable experience and track record in a similar position as Minister or Pastor.

Appointments: The appointment of a successful candidate will initially be on a five-year basis. Bi-vocational candidates in secular employment may also apply should they meet the criteria.

Exact details of the appointment, including establishing a set of key performance indicators, will be determined and agreed between the successful candidate and the Council of UCCCK.
