WORSHIP AND PASTORAL CARE CLUSTER

WORSHIP

1. The Executive Commission instructs the Clerks of the Presbyteries and Synod of Zimbabwe, the Democratic Republic of the Congo and Zambia respectively to submit to the Worship Committee by February 2023 the legal requirements for conducting marriages in each of their countries.

HEALTH AND WELLNESS

1. The Executive Commission during nominations where possible, considers replacing Mrs. PH Lusaseni by appointing Mrs Nomakorinte Mlatsheni from Amathole Presbytery to serve in the GA HWC.
