Founded in 1866, Cambridge Presbyterian Church continues to serve God on its original (and extended) site and strives to share God's light in the community.

The current congregation of 118 avowed members is mostly from the older generation and comes from across the city of East London. While small in number, the congregation has developed an integrated family culture that welcomes everybody into Christ's family.

Activities include house churches, a small Sunday school, working team, Carnes Club with monthly guest speaker, Samaritans delivering food parcels, and monthly men's breakfast.

Our outreach includes Kings & Queens After Care and Seven Star Primary School. These are privately owned and managed establishments operating from the congregation's property.

Session and Board of Management are committed to nurturing and growing the congregation with God's grace and guidance.
