VACANCY: MINISTERIAL POSITION

Applications are invited from a suitable and ordained Ministers of Word and Sacraments in the Uniting Presbyterian Church in Southern Africa for a fulltime five years term appointment, with effect from the 1st January 2025 at Khayelihle Uniting Presbyterian Church situated in uMlazi, Durban, KwaZulu Natal in the Republic of South Africa.

Khayelihle is a congregation situated in the locality of uMlazi township. The said congregation shares a vision of being "Ikhaya labo bonke abantu bakaNkulunkulu, siqhakambisa uthando, ubunye kanye nenhlonipho" roughly translated to mean 'a home of all children of God and pride herself of love, unity and respect.' This congregation has an enrollment of +400 congregants with a potential of growth, meanwhile uMlazi (situated 17km southwest of Durban) has a population of about 400 000, whereas some estimates indicate a higher population figure – up to 1 million people.

Khayelihle has a functional Session which meets at a regular interval. The Stewardship Committee of the Session has always been able to maintain a sustainable financial stability for the congregation. The Session is prepared to pool resources together to provide a competitive emoluments package which will be discussed with the discerned candidate.
