

Applications invited for Minister at Greenacres Presbyterian Church (GAP)

A vacancy has opened at the above church. The current minister has retired and is currently serving a 12-month period as stated supply which ends on 31 March 2025, and we are inviting applications for the post of minister in charge, to start at any time from 1 January 2025.

Our church is a member of the UPCSA. As part of the family of Reformed Churches, we hold to the centrality of Grace, Faith and Scripture in the way we understand the Gospel. We describe our family ethos as "a church where everybody knows your name" in which people can feel safe enough to be real, open enough to discover what Christ has done for them, and free enough to move beyond the past to become all that God designed them to be.

Greenacres Presbyterian Church (GAP) is 119 years old and is multi-cultural with 285 active members who gather for worship every Sunday, enhanced by our dynamic worship team. Oversight is exercised by the Church Session comprised of elders, deacons and associates under the leadership of the Session and the Minister.

A Bachelor of Theology (B.Th.) from an accredited institution and experience in preaching and teaching is required. Competence in counselling, youth ministry, community outreach, and digital ministry within a church context will be regarded as advantageous.

- A minimum of two professional references and one personal reference from a mentor or spiritual leader, all attesting to your exemplary moral character and ministry experience.
